- Tickets on sale starting at 8 am until end of shooting.
- Raffle drawing to start after shooting is completed.
- Drop your raffle tickets in one of 3 containers to win guns OR a variety of sporting goods items.

**Silent Auction**

- The silent auction will be held in the main building from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.
  - Tables will close at 1:00 pm.
  - **Minimum Bid** = the minimum acceptable bid is specified for each item on the bid sheet.
  - **Bid Increments** = the minimum raise amount is specified on each bid sheet.
  - **Valid Bid** = equal to greater than the minimum bid and exactly meets the minimum bid increment.
  - The highest valid bid will be declared the winner at closing time.
- No late bids will be accepted.
  - Winners are not required to be present.
  - **Winners must pay for and pick up items by 2:00 pm.**



## Trap Shoot Safety Rules and Event Guidelines

- Upon arrival at the Trap Shoot Event, all shooter participants will proceed to Registration with their shotgun (12 GAUGE ONLY) uncased, with action open. There, all shotguns will be turned over to Safety Personnel to be inspected and tagged with shooter's team identification information.
- Instructions from Safety Personnel must be followed at all times! Remember that safety is their first responsibility. Failure to follow Safety Personnel instructions will be cause for removal from this event.
- After registration, Safety Personnel will transport all shotguns to their assigned traps – placing shotguns in gun racks for storage until the shooters' team is called to shoot.
- Eye and ear protection is required for all spectators and shooters on the range.
- Any alcoholic beverages are STRICTLY FORBIDDEN until all shooting is completed for the day and all guns stored. Anyone found with alcoholic beverages during the Trap Shoot event will be removed from the premises. **Alcoholic beverages are STRICTLY FORBIDDEN in the parking lots or anywhere on the premises.** One beer will be provided to attendees at the conclusion of the event when all shooting is over and guns are stored.
- When your team is called, shooter's team color and ID tag will be checked at the trap station. Shooters will retrieve their shotgun when instructed to do so by Safety Personnel. Shooters will proceed to the firing line with shotgun's action open. Keep the action open until it is your time to shoot!
- SHOTGUN BARRELS MUST BE POINTED UP AT ALL TIMES!! Please remember to point your shotgun barrel up while advancing to the firing line and while at the firing line waiting for your turn to shoot.
- All shooters are required to exhibit good sportsmanship, safety and common courtesy at all times. Spectators are required to remain behind the sidewalk on the Trap Range.
- Only ammunition provided to you at this event will be allowed at the range.
- Remember to BE SAFE and we will all have a great time at this event
